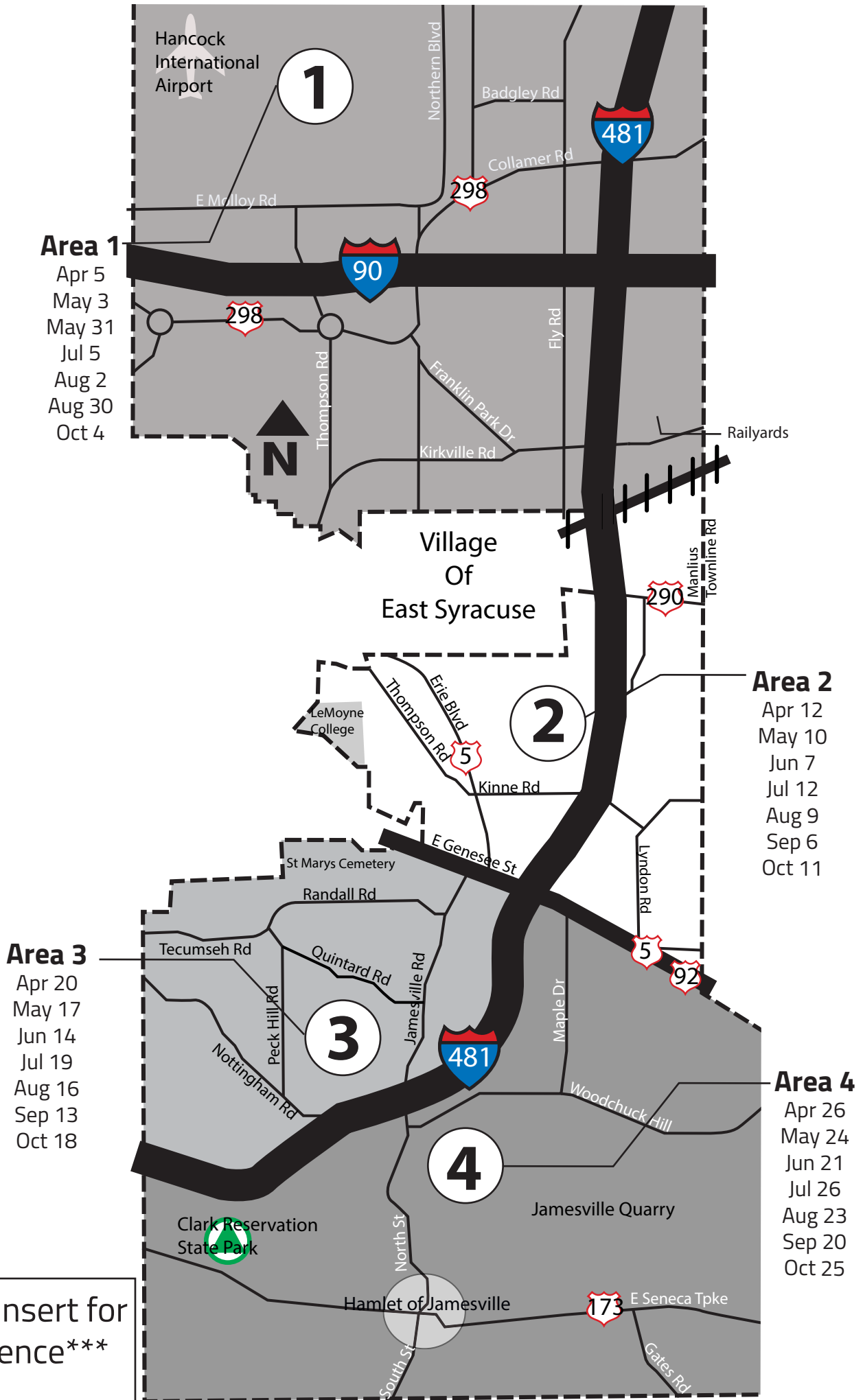
## Yard Waste Information and Pick Up Schedule

The Town provides curbside Yard and Garden Waste Collection Services, as well as leaf collection. Under Federal and State mandates, the Town is required to manage the volume and quality of stormwater that flows through our system. Routine property clean-up helps ensure that stormwater flows into storm grates without debris clogging the system plus it keeps your neighborhoods looking beautiful. In addition, OCRRA accepts yard and garden trimmings as well as food waste at the Amboy location. For small amounts of waste, home composting bins are commercially available. Please do your part to keep water clean.

Please follow these simple guidelines to ensure pick-up. Area Collection Dates are located on the map in the Center Pages.	
Do's	Do Not's
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>ONLY Acceptable Materials Include               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Plant &amp; Shrub Trimmings</li> <li>Plants &amp; Shrubs (No Soil)</li> <li>Sticks, Branches, Limbs (less than 10' in length)</li> </ul> </li> <li>Pile must be shorter than 10' in length</li> <li>Place yard waste at the curb the Sunday of the scheduled pick up. (Trucks only pass through once).</li> <li>Pile must be parallel to the road on yard or driveway—NOT on the road, curb or shoulder.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do NOT Block:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Any part of the road or shoulder</li> <li>Fire Hydrants</li> <li>Gas Shut Offs</li> <li>Utility Poles/Boxes</li> <li>Sewer Vents</li> <li>Drainage Basins (The Town is NOT responsible for repairs to utilities that are blocked, plugged or covered by debris).</li> </ul> </li> <li>Do NOT mix yard waste with trash, recyclables, construction material or any other debris.</li> <li>Do NOT bag material</li> <li>Do NOT add contractor debris.</li> </ul>
<h3>Leaf Collection (November-December)</h3> <p><b>Leaves ONLY - NO brush, twigs, or plants.</b>            No bags. No co-mingled piles. No construction material.            No set schedule. Pick up is <b>weather dependent</b>.            Rake leaves close to the edge of your lawn in a row.</p>
