

Laws of the Town of DeWitt Regarding Snow Removal

161-11 Purpose. This Article provides for the regulation of persons engaged in the business of snow removal in order to promote the health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the Town of DeWitt.

161-12 License required. No person shall, within the Town of DeWitt, engage in or carry on the business of snow plowing for hire without first having obtained a license therefore as hereinafter provided.

161-19.1 Improper removal and disposal of snow and ice. No snowplow operator and no person hiring a snowplow operator shall dispose of, move, push or cause to be disposed of, moved or pushed snow or ice onto the property of another without that person's consent or into the town right-of-way or any street, highway or sidewalk.

161-19 Penalties for offenses. Any conviction for a violation of this article or of any regulation or provision hereof shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$50. A second conviction shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$100. A third conviction shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 or imprisonment for 15 days, or both.
